WHERE DOES YOUR COUNCIL TAX GO?

West Sussex Reset Plan 2021-2025

Local Government taxes have increased by 16% in the last four years. Of the total budget of £1.6bn just £5m (0.3%) is spent on energy and sustainability. Schools, children's services, adult social care cost £1288m, 80% of the total budget. Many struggle to pay these taxes and others wonder why this Council fails to provide decent highway services. The Reset Plan reveals where the money is going.

Increasing Recycling of Household Waste

The Reset Plan claims to focus on what it's doing about Climate Change over the next four years. It defines 52 Key Performance Indicators (KPIs). CC is displayed against only three KPIs. Of these only KPI 23 will advance this claim. We support the collection and processing of food waste to avoid Methane from land-fill. At the moment there's insufficient anaerobic digestor plant capacity to treat food waste from every household in Mid Sussex. That facility must be **built now**.

WHAT'S OUR GREEN PLAN IN WEST SUSSEX?

We will campaign to raise awareness about the environmental cost of food waste, encouraging good shopping, avoiding impulse purchases and doing more home cooking, We will find out if waste is 'recycled' or is it going to land-fill or incineration.



Share with Care

We will campaign for traffic calming in Haywards Heath town centre and encourage, walking and cycling instead of short car journeys. We will champion safe cycle routes from Haywards Heath to Lindfield and Scaynes Hill and between Cuckfield and Haywards Heath, Harlands Road .

Central government's most recent £2bn 'Green Homes Grant' scheme failure follows on from the 2012 Coalition government's 'Green New Deal' which was killed off by high interest rates and lack of ambition.



We will enable retrofitting existing homes to reduce greenhouse emissions.

We will encourage and work with developers to offer ecoupgrades to people buying new build homes off-plan

HAYWARDS HEATH TOWN CENTRE MASTER PLAN

Green Party Councillors at Mid Sussex DC were not satisfied with the Haywards Heath Town Centre Master Plan and did not approve the Supplementary Planning Document on 31st March. The plan does not even think about climate change or greenhouse gases. Low-traffic neighbourhoods are needed to cut air pollution to protect everyone's health and well-being. We also question the proposals in the SPD to close small car parks including Franklynn Road and build a multi-story carpark at The Orchards.
