STOP THE TORY "CASH GRAB" OF BURGESS HILL

On 23rd March, Conservative district councillors voted that all new households in the Burgess Hill Northern Arc should now be considered part of Ansty, not Burgess Hill. This flew in the face of council officer recommendations. So, all the parish council tax of these houses in the *Burgess Hill Growth Area* would go not to Burgess Hill but to Ansty, a small village with a recently-built £1.4 million cricket pavilion.

Dunstall ward will suffer the mud and dust and noise of the building process, and the increased traffic during and afterwards, and yet none of the local council tax would come to Burgess Hill. But it's our town amenities the new residents will be using: they won't be going to Ansty to take a train, or to Ansty to shop.

Green councillors have already shown they work hard to balance the effects of some of the decisions that the higher tiers of local government (District and County) have imposed on the town. But the town could really suffer if this "cash grab" is allowed.

Can you do anything about this? Yes, you can!

You can sign the petition which is circulating (on paper only). If enough signatures are gathered in the next few weeks of people who object to this manoeuvre, this will trigger a "Community Governance Review". In this way we can stop this injustice happening, using **people power**.

You can cast your vote for me, Gail Anderson, Green Party on 7th April so that you elect a local councillor who will fight against this.

Don't let people who don't even live here condemn this town to yet more years of dereliction and dilapidation. Even if you don't normally come into the town centre, please do so next Saturday to sign the petition.




YOU DECIDE:
